SEPTEMBER WELCOME NEWSLETTER

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome to Little Gregs Pre-School! I hope you have had an enjoyable summer. This is the first newsletter of the pre-school year.

We are all very excited to see all the children back at pre-school and Welcome our new families to Little Gregs. Pre-school reopens Tuesday 3rd September 2024.

The first few weeks at pre-school will be allowing the children to settle in, develop friendships with children and staff. The children will be exploring the learning environment and adapting to the routines.

I know this is an unsettling time for you and your child, we will do our very best to meet your child's needs, ensuring a smooth transition into pre-school. I will be on the gate in the mornings to take any messages and to answer any questions. In the mornings you will drop off at the main black gate at the front of the school. We have strict times at the gate in the morning, we have been given a 10 minute slot 8.30am – 8.40am. Please ensure you are on time. If you are late you will have to wait for St Gregory's children arrive for their allocated time. Then you will be allowed to enter the school grounds to walk around to the pre-school. Afternoon collection is from the pre-school and the pre-school gate is opened from 3pm.

We will continue to provide free snack morning and afternoon sessions, along with milk and water.

Your child will need a pair of wellingtons and all in-ones to keep at pre-school for nature nursery and outdoor activities. Children will need a drinks bottle for each session, change of clothes and nappies (if they are in nappies). We provide you with a pre-school bag. If you have not received you bag, please ensure you ask at the pre-school office. Please ensure all belonging are clearly labelled with your child's name!

There is a new system in place for booking holidays, this is a safeguarding requirement and we must follow this requirement. If you take holiday during the pre-school term, you must inform Sarah or Helen, and complete a holiday form. Please do not email the day before your holiday or tell staff at the gate. If we are not informed of the holiday, and cannot make contact with you. We have to report the child as missing in early year's education to the local authority.






DATES FOR THE DIARY
